Come enjoy the beautiful 10-foot wide recreational Shore Road walkway that meanders along the coastline complete with gardens, benches, and decorative lighting along.

Fifteen-years ago the Village of Port Washington North Planning Board came up with an idea of a baywalk to resemble the work Garden City did in their Village years ago. A planning grant from NY State made possible the design for what will become the Bay Walk Waterfront Park. It will not only include the walkway, but an active recreational park with a working pier for boat traffic. Various grants totaling about \$4 million have restored our waterfront and also Shore Road which is adjacent to the Park. Phase I is almost complete – the walkway is done and the pier is restored. Come enjoy a walk along our wonderfully restored coastline!

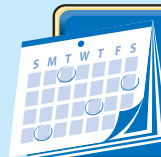
