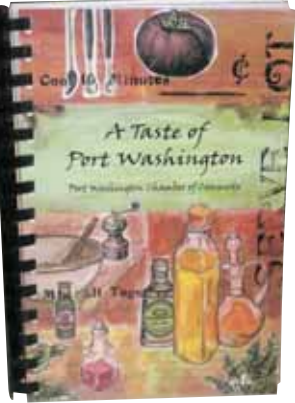

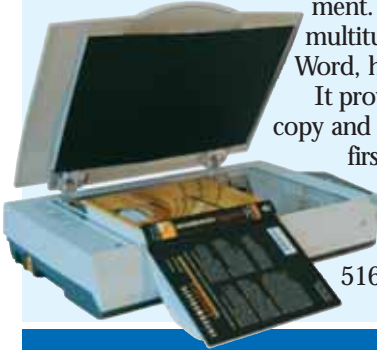
PW Library Acquires Library Scan Station

Patrons can scan precious family photos and documents in black-and-white or color and save to a USB drive, share on a social media site, or e-mail the document. Files can be saved in a multitude of formats including Word, html, jpg, tif or pdf.

It provides "green" self-service copy and scan solutions and is the first self-service eco-friendly scan station in Nassau County.
