PW School District Registration for Fall 2011



If your family includes a child who will be entering kindergarten in Port Washington in September 2011, this information is important to you. Children must be five-years old on or before December 1, 2011 to begin kindergarten in the fall. Early registration helps in planning for necessary staff and also ensures that any necessary placement tests are completed.

Appointments Required

Registration takes place Jan. 4 - Feb. 3, 2011 according to which school they will be attending. **You must make an appointment to register your child** by calling 767-5470 from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm. Registration for all schools is in the Department of Community Services in the Administrative Annex at 90 Avenue C.

The registration packet for new students and incoming kindergarteners can be downloaded from the school district website, www.portnet.k12.ny.us or picked up in the Administrative Annex at 90 Avenue C.

Please understand that in accordance with Board of Education policy, **no child will be admitted to school without all the necessary forms completed.**


