

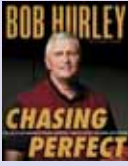

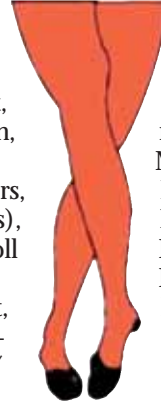

## When is Enough Enough? Ethics and End of Life Choices Thursday April 18

The PW Library will host a panel discussion, "Ethics and End of Life Choices – When is Enough Enough?" at 7:30 pm. The evening's panel of experts will be: Margaret Battin, PhD, Distinguished Professor of Philosophy and Medical Ethics at the University of Utah; Dr. Robert C. Cassidy, PhD, Bioethicist and Adjunct Professor at Touro Law School; Dr. Peter Rogatz, MD, founder of Compassion in Dying and currently VP of the Board of Directors of Compassion and Choices, and Ellen G. Makofsky, Esq. who specializes in Elder Law and was selected as a Top 50
